

The Mid-Term process provides students and advisors the knowledge to better understand their current academic status in their classes. The mid-term grades for letter graded courses will be submitted with letter grades of A, B, C, D and F (there will be no + or – grades). The mid-term grades for Pass/Fail courses will be submitted as H (Honors), S (Satisfactory) and U (Unsatisfactory).

The mid-term grade rosters will be open for instructors to submit grades until Sunday, October 20th at 9:00 PM. Some grades may not be present before this date.
