

University Monitored Withdrawal Request

This form is used to request a withdrawal from a class resulting in a "W" notation. A "W" counts as an attempt toward your course repeat maximum. This decision is permanent and irreversible. There will be no tuition adjustment or refund for withdrawing from an individual class. Withdrawing from course(s) or the entire academic term reduces your annual enrollment intensity and may reduce your federal aid eligibility which may create a balance owed on your account, even if the aid has already been disbursed.

This form will not be processed if information is incomplete or inaccurate. Submit this form to the Academic Center offering the class no later than the deadline published in the [Enrollment Calendar](#) by the Office of the University Registrar for that term. Sending this form to the incorrect location may result in processing delays.

For withdrawal from all courses in a term, use the Late Term Withdrawal Request form instead.
