1. Application for Admission
2. Official High School Transcript, GED, or Self-Reported Academic Record (SRAR available on the On-Line Application for Admission)
3. SAT/ACT Scores: Students applying for admission for Fall 2026 and beyond may choose whether or not to submit SAT/ACT scores.
4. Letter(s) of Recommendation: Optional
5. Essay or Personal Statement: Optional
