

SPRING BREAK RESIDENCE HALL CLOSURE

Residence halls are closed during Spring Break. The official closing time is 9 p.m., Friday, March 6. The only students permitted to remain on campus beyond that point are student-athletes, who are required to be here as part of their NCAA collegiate sport(s). Exceptions can be made on a case-by-case basis (subject to room availability) for international students, domestic students living more than 300 miles from campus, or those with housing insecurities.

ALL students needing to stay over Spring Break must submit a Spring Break Request, which is available in the “Housing Forms & Tasks” section of the Housing Portal. **The deadline to submit the request is 5 p.m., Wednesday, February 25.**

Unfortunately, the following are **not acceptable reasons for needing to remain on campus when residence halls are closed:**

- being scheduled to work at an off-campus job,
- failing to make travel arrangements in advance, or
- wanting to attend events in the area.

All non-student-athletes approved to stay during Spring Break will be given a temporary reassignment to a residence hall equipped with a kitchen and where staff supervision is available. Spring break housing is offered as a courtesy to students at no charge and is not part of your housing contract. It is also subject to availability. Therefore, private rooms cannot be guaranteed and our ability to provide medical housing accommodations is limited.

Student-athletes staying over Spring Break will remain in their regularly assigned rooms and meals will be coordinated through their coach.

Please do not assume that you will be provided with housing over spring break. **Students who fail to submit a request by the February 25 deadline will not be considered for Spring Break housing** and will need to leave campus when the residence halls close. Failure to read this message is not an excuse for missing the deadline or claiming you were not informed.
