

## Greek Organization Summer Storage Waiver

### Terms and Conditions

Having been granted organizational housing status, the undersigned representative has requested permission to store official organizational items in their assigned lodge during summer break 2026. Pursuant to this request, I, the undersigned representative, on behalf of the organization, agree and acknowledge that:

- I am authorized by the organization to serve as its official agent in the capacity of house manager or president.
- University does not accept responsibility for maintaining organizational belongings stored and assumes no responsibility for loss, damage, decay, vandalism, theft, or destruction of any kind.
- Any items found above the ceiling will be confiscated and discarded by the University.
- Any items stored in a manner that presents a fire hazard or any safety risk will be removed and discarded.
- Organization agrees to release, hold harmless and indemnify the University of Pittsburgh at Johnstown, their officers, employees, agents and representatives, from any and all liability to me, members of the organization, or any organizational affiliates and assigns for any and all claims, demands and causes of action for any and all loss arising out of, resulting from, occurring during or in any way connected with or caused by negligence or gross negligence of Indemnitees that may be sustained by the organization as a result of this agreement.
- Only items belonging to the organization (i.e., paddles, signage, staging, furniture) are permitted to remain in the facility. No personal belongings may be kept on campus over the summer. The University reserves the right to deem personal belongings as abandoned property and remove and discard those items accordingly.
- All items being stored must be packed into study boxes or containers (ideally plastic containers with sealing lids). Packed containers can weigh no more than 50 pounds each. No loose items can remain on shelves, tables, etc. otherwise they will be discarded.
- Furniture must be placed in such a way that it does not impede access to any rooms, stairwells, or exits. Furniture should not be stacked.
- Any change in organizational housing status changes made after May 1, 2026 may nullify this agreement and the organization will be responsible for removing all items from the house by a deadline established by the University.
- No members of the organization shall be granted access to the facility during summer recess unless required to do so as a result of a change in organizational housing status.
- University may alert proper law enforcement of any evidence of criminal activity discovered while engaging in activities related to this request.
