

<u>Eligibility</u>

To be considered eligible for election to the UPJ Student Government Association (SGA) as an upperclassman you must:

- Be an enrolled as an upper-class student at the University of Pittsburgh Johnstown.
- Have at least 24 credits.
- Collect **50 (fifty)** signatures from **individual** students (not including your own signature).
- Have a Quality Point Average (QPA) of at least 2.00.

Duties and Expectations

To be considered for election a student must be willing to:

- Meet as a General Senate bi-weekly for around one and a half (1.5) hours on Monday evenings.
- Meet in committees on the opposing weeks for around a half (.5) an hour on Monday evenings.
- Adhere to and sign the SGA Code of Ethics upon election to a seat.
- Adhere to all policies and procedures laid out in SGA Constitution as well as any policies or procedures enacted by the Executive Board or Senate as a whole.
- Adhere to all University policies and procedures.

Intention to Run
