# REVIEW, UPDATE & IMPLEMENT EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLANS

- Include strategies to reduce the spread of a wide variety of infectious diseases Use hand-washing signs & window clings
- Utilize our parent info sheets provide
- Have hand sanitizers containing at least 60% alcohol if soap and water are not available
- Include common-sense preventative actions for students and staff Use posters and signs

# DEVELOP INFORMATION-SHARING SYSTEMS WITH PARTNERS

- · Utilize text messaging and emails to parents for daily updates
- · Work with local health officials to obtain information

#### MONITOR & PLAN FOR ABSENTEEISM

- · Inform parents and staff of absentee policy
- Alert local health officials of a large number of absent individuals that appear to have a respiratory illness
- Encourage students and staff to stay home when they are sick
- Be flexible with staff to stay home to care for sick family members
- · Discourage perfect attendance awards

# ESTABLISH PROCEDURES FOR STUDENTS & STAFF WHO ARE SICK AT SCHOOL

- Isolate sick students and staff from well students and staff until they can leave
- Establish a plan for students who get sick at school or arrive sick at school

### PERFORM ROUTINE ENVIRONMENTAL CLEANING

- Routinely clean touch surfaces
   Doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handrails, elevator buttons
- Provide disposable wipes so commonly used surfaces can be wiped down between student use Keyboards, desks, remote controls
