About the Alumni Association Junior Legacy Scholarship

The Junior Legacy Scholarship has been established by the Pitt-Johnstown Alumni Association to assist junior year students as of fiscal year June 2018-2019, and to celebrate the important connection between alumni and their alma mater. The award amount is \$1,500, non-renewable beyond the first semester of the award. The recipients of the scholarship shall be selected by a review committee comprised of members of the Pitt-Johnstown Alumni Association board of directors.

Eligibility:

- Applicant must be the son, daughter, grandson, granddaughter, or sibling of a Pitt-Johnstown alumnus who is a current Gold member of the Pitt-Johnstown Alumni Association.
- Applicant must be a junior at Pitt-Johnstown in the fiscal year July 2018 to June 2019 with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Applicant must submit a written essay answering the question: “Why did you choose Pitt-Johnstown and how is your attendance here shaping your future?”
- Applicant must be enrolled on a full-time basis (12 to 18 credits per semester) for the fiscal year.
- Students who receive the REB Commuter Scholarship are not eligible to receive the Legacy Scholarship.

Application Process:

- Applicants must submit:
 - 1) Your contact information, including:
 - a. Full Name
 - b. Preferred Phone Number
 - c. Pitt Email Address
 - d. Full Name Family Member Who is Pitt-Johnstown Alumnus/Alumni Association Member, including:
 - i. Graduation Year
 - ii. Name While Attending (if different from above)
 - 2) A one-page essay that answers the question: “Why have you chosen Pitt-Johnstown and how is your attendance here shaping your future?”
